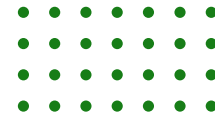

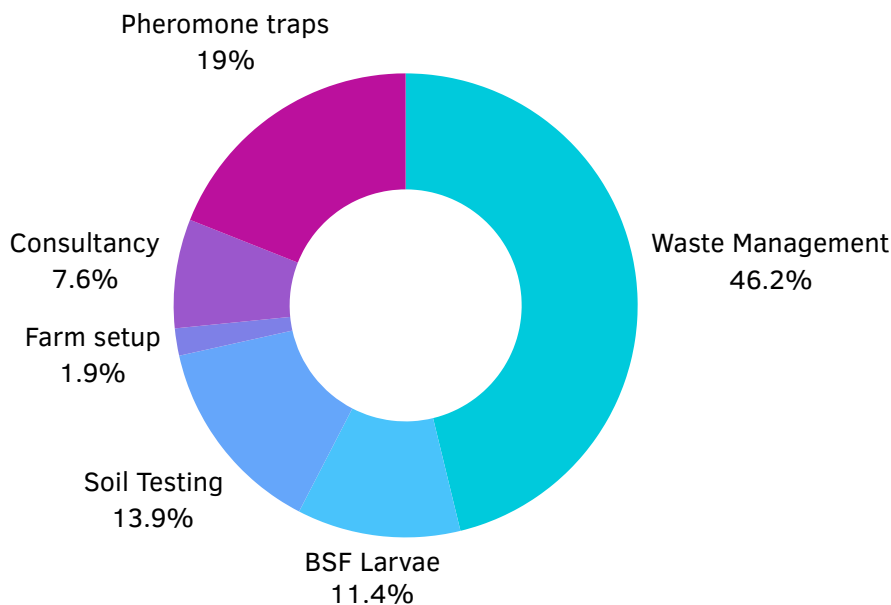

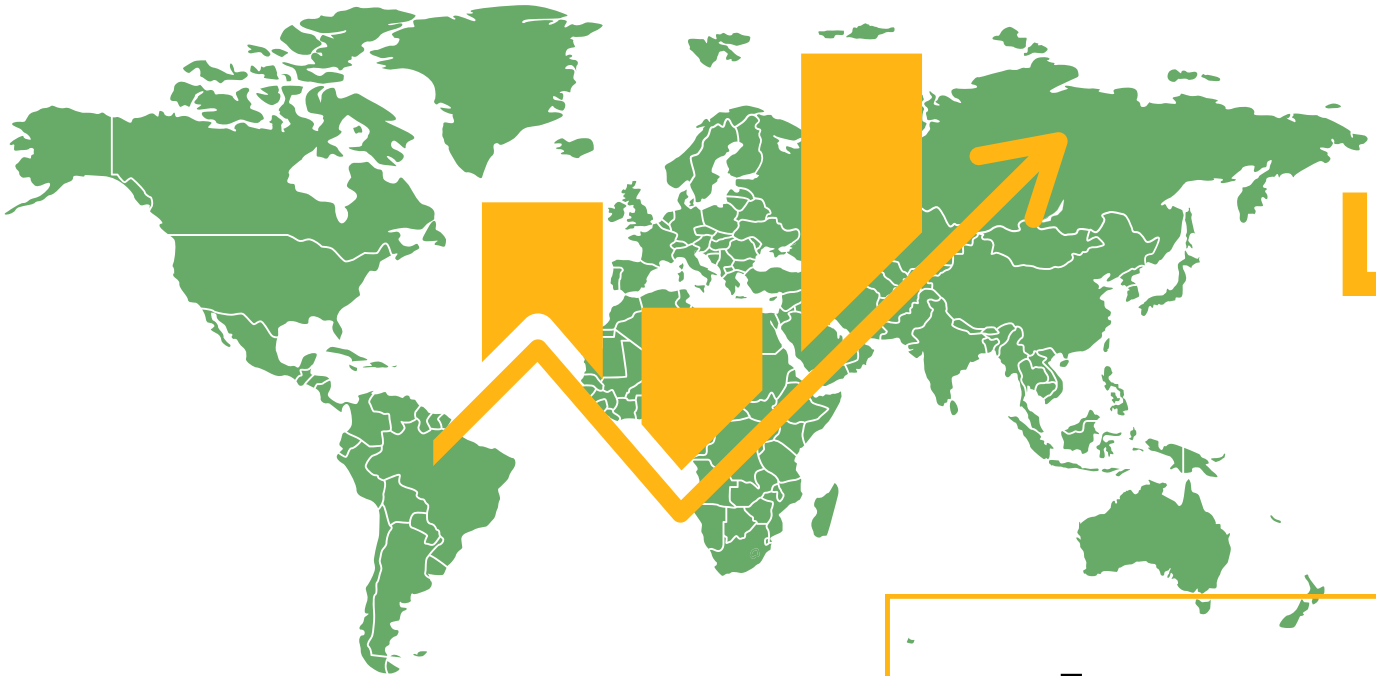

ST4A Seeds Program - Einstein Raising, Kampala

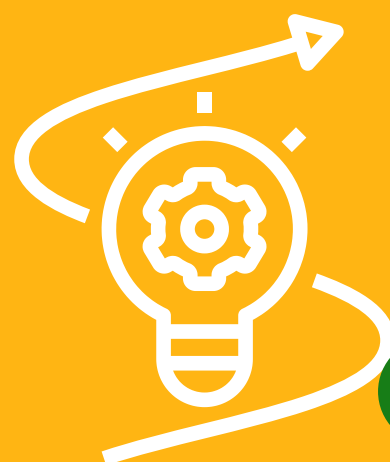
